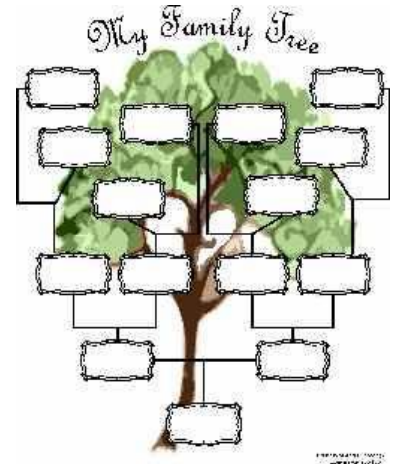

The Dream: A Memoir—Harry Bernstein

In English III this year, we will be exploring two essential questions: What are the core values of American culture? and is the American Dream worth pursuing? *The Dream: A Memoir* by Harry Bernstein focuses on both of these questions.

Part I-Bernstein Family Tree

When reading a non-fiction piece of literature, it is important to focus on the connection between family members. One way to do this is by organizing the people by creating a family tree. Create a complete family tree of the Bernstein family. Include all of the family and extended family members in the book. You will be graded on accuracy, neatness, and creativity.



Part II-Timeline

Create a timeline of the major events in the book. Follow in Mrs. Bernstein's (Harry's mother) footsteps as she pursues her dream of coming to America. Your journey begins from the time she receives the steamship tickets in the mail and continues until the end of the book. Be sure to include all important information.

Your timeline should:

- Be organized chronologically.
- Include at least twenty events (However, you can include more).
- Be typed, and you will be graded on accuracy, thoroughness, and neatness (If your timeline is not typed, you will not receive credit).
