

Support Groups at Lakes Community High School

A number of support and educational groups will be offered to students at Lakes Community High School. Groups will meet once a week and, in most cases, during the school day. Groups will rotate through periods, so students do not miss one class a number of times. Students will be excused from class to participate in group but are expected to make up work missed during that period. Groups are open, in most cases, and will be available for students who need support throughout the school year. Students may refer themselves or may be referred by a school professional or parent. A brief interview will be held prior to students beginning the group to explain the rules of confidentiality and to establish group procedures.

Concerned Persons

This is a group for students who are negatively impacted by the drug and alcohol use of someone close to them, whether it be a family member or a friend.

Women's Issues

This group is for women who need support in setting healthy boundaries, establishing and maintaining positive relationships, and maintaining a positive self image.

Men's Issues

This group is for young men who need support in setting healthy boundaries, establishing and maintaining positive relationships, and maintaining a positive self image.

Divorce

This is a group for students who have lost someone close to them and need support in dealing with that loss.
