



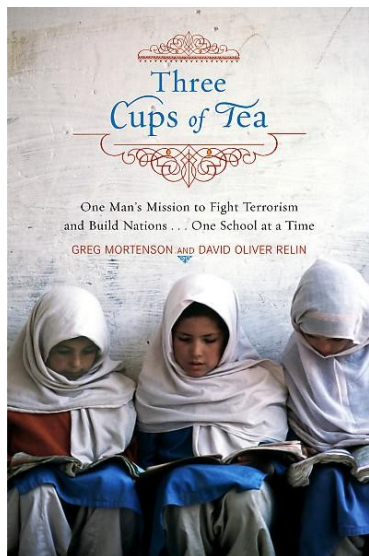

Three Cups of Tea: One Man's Mission to Fight Terrorism and Build Nations ... One School at a Time by Greg Mortenson

High up in the world's most inhospitable mountains, Greg Mortenson wandered lost and alone, broken in body and spirit. When the people of an impoverished village in Pakistan's Karakoram Himalaya took him in and nursed him back to health, he made an impulsive promise: He would return one day and build them a school. As director of the Central Asia Institute, Mortenson has guided the construction of 55 schools in poor communities of Pakistan and Afghanistan.

Mortenson's story is proof that one person can truly change lives. Our discussion will center on how we, as members of the LCHS learning community, can affect change within our school and our own communities.
