SKILL 1: Long Pass/Clearing Kick

- Plant foot slightly behind and beside the ball.
- Kicking foot has toe down.
- Ball is contacted on in-step (shoelaces).
- Foot contacts the lower half of the ball giving the ball a high trajectory.



SKILL 2: Short push pass

- Toe is turned out, contact take place on instep
- Ankle is locked in place, body is balanced
- Ball travels on the ground
- Foot follow-throughs towards target



SKILL 3: Dribbling/Ball Control

- Inside/outside/top of toe is used
- Ball remains close to body
- Touch on ball is light and controlled
- Directional changes can be applied

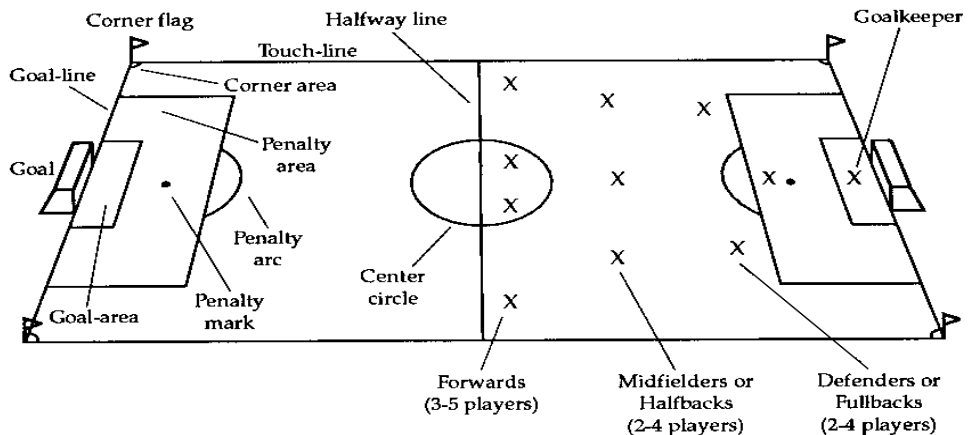
SKILL 4: Throw-In/trap

- **THROW IN:** Arm motion comes directly over head
- **THROW IN:** Both feet maintain contact with the ground
- **TRAP:** Body moves to the ball
- **TRAP:** Body "gives" with ball, ball drops in front of body.

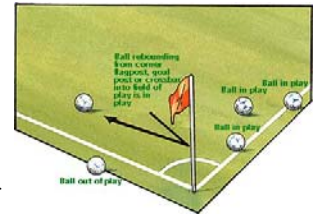

FIELD BOUNDARIES:



THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS: A match is played by two teams, each consisting of not more than eleven players, one of whom is the goalkeeper. A match may not start if either team consists of fewer than seven players.



BALLS IN AND OUT OF PLAY:
The ball is out of play when:

- It has completely crossed the goal line or touch line whether on the ground or in the air
 - Balls crossing the touch line are entered into play using a **throw in**.
 - Balls crossing the goal line are entered into play defensively as a **goal kick** and offensively as a **corner kick**.
- play has been stopped by the referee

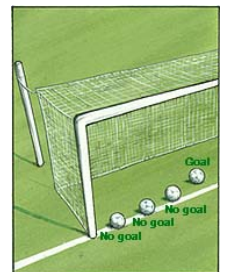
The ball is in play at all other times, including when:

- it rebounds from a goalpost, crossbar or corner flag post and remains in the field of play
- it rebounds from either the referee or an assistant referee when they are on the field of play

PROCEDURE FOR KICK OFF:

- all players are in their own half of the field
- the opponents of the team taking the kick-off are at least 9.15 m (10 yds) from the ball until it is in play
- the ball is stationary on the center mark
- the referee gives a signal
- the ball is in play when it is kicked and moves forward
- the kicker does not touch the ball a second time until it has touched another player
- After a team scores a goal, the other team takes the kick-off.

GOALS SCORED: A goal is scored when the entire ball passes over the goal line, between the goalposts and under the crossbar, if the team scoring the goal has committed no infringement of the laws of the game previously.



DIRECT KICK: is awarded to the opposing team if a player commits any of the following six offences in a manner considered by the referee to be careless, reckless or using excessive force (Kicks may be directed at the goal and do not have to touch another player):

- Kicks or attempts to kick an opponent
- Trips or attempts to trip an opponent
- Jumps at an opponent
- Charges an opponent
- Strikes or attempts to strike an opponent
- Pushes an opponent
- Tackles an opponent to gain possession of the ball, making contact with the opponent before touching the ball
- Holds an opponent
- Spits at an opponent
- Handles the ball deliberately (except for the goalkeeper within his own penalty area)

AN INDIRECT FREE KICK: is awarded to the opposing team if a goalkeeper, inside his own penalty area, commits any of the following offences (Kicks must touch another player prior to being shot on goal):

- takes more than six seconds while controlling the ball with his hands, before releasing it from his possession
- touches the ball again with his hands after it has been released from his possession and has not touched any other player
- touches the ball with his hands after it has been deliberately kicked to him by a team-mate
- touches the ball with his hands after he has received it directly from a throw-in taken by a team-mate
- plays in a dangerous manner
- impedes the progress of an opponent
- prevents the goalkeeper from releasing the ball from his hands
