Theatre director serves on Illinois High School Theatre Festival’s Executive Committee

Bridget Sundin, director of theatre productions at Lakes Community High School, has been invited to serve on the Executive Committee for the 2012 Illinois High School Theatre Festival.

Sundin has served on the committee before. In her new role, she will be responsible for coordinating program ads, corporate sponsorships, and donations for the 37th annual festival, which will be held at Illinois State University Jan. 5-7, 2012. The position is new not only to Sundin, but also to the committee itself.

More than 4,000 students from across the state participate in the festival each year, watching shows put on by other high schools and attending various theatre workshops. Two past LCHS productions have qualified to perform at ITF under Sundin’s direction. This year, the cast and crew members of her fall play *John Lennon and Me* earned a spot in the program. Sundin also co-produced the 2009 all-state play *Hairspray*.

Next year’s ITF theme is “The Art of Connection.”
