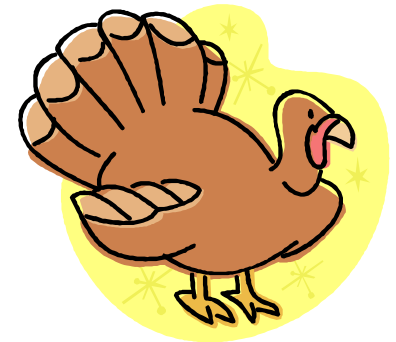

Buses will run the morning routes at the regular times.

Buses will also run at **10:30 am** and **12:00 Noon each day ***

* The 12:00 Noon run on Wednesday will be a late bus run.

During the three (3) days of finals, parents will not have to call a student in late or out early if they have study hall the first or last hour of the testing schedule. However, if a student is going to be missing an exam, we must receive a call from the parent/guardian so the student is not considered truant. Please note that no lunch service will be provided during final exams.

Students have the option of coming to school late and leaving early; however, once a student has arrived, the student is expected to remain on campus. Students who enter during an exam period must stay in the Commons and will not be allowed to enter the academic hallways. Students should be on time for all exams. Students must take their exams at the designated exam time. Students who miss their designated exam time risk receiving an incomplete for the course or may be subject to an alternate assessment.

Lower Library and Commons Area – These spaces are quiet study areas. Students must remain in these areas for the entire exam period.

The Library is open at 7:00 am for students needing a place to study and work.
